

Historian

- The Historian collects and preserves troop photographs, news stories, trophies, flags, scrapbooks, awards, and other memorabilia and makes materials available for Scouting activities, the media, and troop history projects
- The Historian preserves troop photographs, news stories, trophies, flags, scrapbooks, awards, and other memorabilia. Serving as Historian can apply towards Positions of Responsibility requirements for Eagle in a Boy Scout Troop.
- The Historian is appointed by the senior patrol leader.

As Historian, I will document the activities of my Troop:

- Maintain and add to the Troop history record on the Troop web site
- Publish photographs from Troop activities on the Troop web site
- Submit at least one article about a Troop event to a local newspaper
- Write about Troop awards and recognitions in the Troop record
- Update Troop record information, such as new Eagle Scouts, Troop leaders, Troop roster
- Keep historic items safe such as ribbons, awards, and memorabilia
- Wear my uniform correctly, set a good example, practice the Scout Oath and Law
- Fulfill the requirements of this position for 6 months
